**4. Title:** General registrars; residency requirement; exemption for certain counties and cities.

**5. Summary:** Exempts counties and cities with a population of 25,000 or less from the requirement that a person appointed to serve as a general registrar must be a qualified voter of the county or city for which he is appointed. The bill maintains current law allowing that in the case of a city that is wholly contained within one county, the city general registrar may be a qualified voter of that county.
