**4. Title:** Motorboats; means of propulsion; wake surfing.

**5. Summary:** This bill allows a motorboat that is propelled by a means that is below the water line and forward of a transom or an integrated swim platform to be accompanied by a person in the water. Current law allows a motorboat to be accompanied by such a wakesurfer only if the motorboat is propelled by an inboard motor.
