**4. Title:** Military medical personnel program; supervision.

**5. Summary:** Provides that military medical personnel in a program, established by the Department of Veterans Services, who may perform certain delegated acts that constitute the practice of medicine while under the supervision of a physician or podiatrist may also perform such acts under the supervision of the chief medical officer, or his designee, of an organization participating in the program. In addition, the bill removes the designation of this program as a pilot program.
