**8. Fiscal Implications:** The fiscal impact of this bill primarily involves the costs associated with meetings and staff support. The Senate of Virginia anticipates their portion of meeting and staffing costs each year will be approximately \$4,920, while the House of Delegates costs are approximately \$6,780. The Division of Legislative Services anticipates their portion of the meeting, staff, and support costs each year will be approximately \$8,460. These costs are based on the five legislative members, four nonlegislative citizen members, and 10 ex officio members attending an assumed four meetings. The Department of Education anticipates technical assistance costs to be minimal and absorbed within existing resources, however, the bill does not clearly define technical assistance and additional resources may be required. The cost to the House and Senate may be less if an appropriation is provided to the new commission.
