**3. Committee:** General Laws and Technology

**4. Title:** Virginia Public Procurement Act; methods of procurement, single or term contracts.

**5. Summary:** Increases the maximum permissible aggregate or sum of all phases of single or term contracts for professional services that may be procured without requiring competitive negotiation from \$60,000 to \$80,000. The substitute bill also increases the maximum total amount of all construction projects that may be performed in a one-year contract term of a contract for architectural or professional engineering services relating to multiple construction projects from \$500,000 to \$750,000, which applies to localities with populations of 78,000 or less.
