4. Title: Department of Veterans Services

5. Summary:

Currently, the Department of Veterans Services (DVS) is required by law to perform cost-benefit and value analyses on existing programs and services and on new programs and services before establishing and implementing them. The proposed language would require that these analyses be performed annually and the results reported to the Secretary of Veterans and Defense Affairs (the Secretary).

The proposed legislation would also make it explicit that DVS reports, and is responsible, to the Secretary. Finally, it would require DVS to submit an annual report to the Secretary, the Governor, and the General Assembly.

8. Fiscal Implications:

According to DVS, the agency currently prepares an annual report and performs the analyses that would be required by the proposed legislation; consequently, the legislation would have no fiscal impact on the agency.
