3. Committee: Local Government

4. Title: Tourism Development Authority; LENOWISCO and Cumberland Plateau Planning District Commissions.

5. Summary: This bill reorganizes the Tourism Development Authority by increasing board membership and creating tourism advisory committees.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not result in a state fiscal impact. The bill specifies that the board of directors shall create two ex-officio nonvoting board positions for representatives from the Jefferson National Forest Clinch Ranger District Office and Virginia State Parks. The Department of Conservation and Recreation does not anticipate a fiscal impact as a result of this provision.
