2. Patron: Mason

3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: General registrars; residency requirement; exemption for certain counties and cities.

5. Summary: Exempts counties and cities with a population of 25,000 or less from the requirement that a person appointed to serve as a general registrar must be a qualified voter of the county or city for which he is appointed.

The bill also maintains current law allowing that in the case of a city that is wholly contained within one county, the city general registrar may be a qualified voter of that county.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No state fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Elections and localities.
