2. Patron: DeSteph

3. Committee: Transportation

4. Title: Vehicle registration extension for satisfaction of certain requirements

5. Summary: This bill expands eligibility for a one-month extension of a vehicle registration period to include persons whose vehicle registration has been withheld for failure to pay tolls.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles will incur costs of \$92,541 for information systems programming to implement the bill that will be recouped through the \$10 administrative fee imposed.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Motor Vehicles.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: Yes, Line 15, after “§,” insert “§.” This sentence references multiple sections. In addition, Line 16, after “46.2-819.1,” consideration may be given to including “46.2-819.3,” applicable to toll violations occurring at traditional toll booths.

11. Other Comments: This bill is similar to HB 1069.
