3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions

4. Title: Virginia Health Club Act; automated external defibrillator required in health clubs.

5. Summary: This bill, as passed by the Senate, requires each health club location to have a working automated external defibrillator.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact of this bill is indeterminate. The Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (VDACS) does not currently conduct inspections to ensure compliance with the Virginia Health Club Act. If the department is required to conduct inspections, additional personnel may be needed. Many health clubs are exempt from the Virginia Health Club Act, and the total number of health clubs in Virginia is unknown.
