**4. Title:**    Graduation requirements; clock hours.

**5. Summary:** Requires the Board of Education, in its graduation requirements, to permit a passing score on an industry certification approved by the local school board or any instruction received, coursework completed, or study toward achieving such passing score to count toward the requirement for a student to receive 140 clock hours of instruction for any course, regardless of subject matter relevance, provided that such achievement, instruction, coursework, or study occurs after the student has completed the course curriculum and relevant Standards of Learning assessment.
