5. Summary: Creates an Internet beer retailer license. The bill establishes the privileges of and fee for the license, and defines the term "Internet beer retailer."

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed bill establishes the internet beer retailers license and sets the annual license fee at \$150 per year. It is not possible to estimate the revenue the license fee is expected to generate annually at this time.

According to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority (ABC), the proposed bill is expected to have a minimal fiscal impact on ABC operations and no material impact on profit transfers to the general fund.
