- 4. Title: Campaign finance; with whom former candidates file reports.
- 5. Summary: Requires a former candidate for local or constitutional office who is no longer seeking election but has not yet filed a final report as required by law and who files reports in nonelectronic format to file with the general registrar of the locality in which he sought office. In the case of a former candidate for local or constitutional office who is no longer seeking election but has not yet filed a final report who files reports electronically, the State Board of Elections shall promptly notify and make the information in the report available to the general registrar of the locality in which the candidate sought office.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: See Item 8.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: As stand-alone legislation, the Department of Elections considers implementation of this bill as "routine," and does not require additional funding. However, the agency will review all electoral legislation likely to be enacted prior to the passage by each house. If the aggregate number of "routine" bills likely to pass either house is unusually large, it is possible the agency will require additional resources. If so, the Department of Elections will identify the costs at that time.
