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5. Summary:

Currently, the Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) is required to periodically review each pretrial services agency to determine its compliance with its submitted plan and the operating standards.

The proposed legislation provides that the review now required of DCJS be conducted on an "annual" basis. The legislation would also require DCJS to submit an annual report to the Governor and General Assembly detailing the performance of each pretrial services program.
