Summary:** Requires any vertically integrated carrier, which is a health insurer or other carrier that owns an interest in an acute care hospital facility, to offer to every public hospital the ability to participate in the provider panels or networks established for each of the carrier's policies, products, and plans. Such participation shall be without any adverse tiering or other financial incentives that may discourage enrollees from utilizing the services of the public hospital and include all services offered by the public hospital and any other entity owned, operated, or controlled by a public hospital, in whole or in part.
