4. Title Inspections prior to sale; exception; certain special orders

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill exempts from the requirement that motor vehicles be inspected prior to retail sale transactions a motor vehicle that is sold on the basis of a special order placed with a dealer or manufacturer outside the Commonwealth by a dealer who makes modifications to such vehicle prior to delivery to the first retail customer who takes delivery outside the Commonwealth. The bill expands the existing exception for dealers who order from a manufacturer outside the Commonwealth on behalf of a nonresident of the Commonwealth to include orders made with another dealer outside the Commonwealth. The bill also contains a technical amendment.
