3. Committee: House Committee on Commerce and Labor

4. Title: Volunteer fire companies

5. Summary: Removes the requirement that participation by certain minors in certain fire company activities requires local government authorization. The bill also provides that participation by such minors in nonhazardous activities of a volunteer fire company, including fire prevention efforts and training courses, are not prohibited.

The bill directs the Virginia Fire Services Board to adopt a junior member policy that provides guidance to fire and rescue departments in developing and administering nonhazardous training courses and programs.
