11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 38.2-3449.1 as follows:
13	§ 38.2-3449.1. Prohibited discrimination based on gender identity or status as a transgender
14	individual.
15	A. As used in this section:
16 17	"Gender identity" means an individual's internal sense of gender, which may be male, female, neither, or a combination of male and female and which may be different from an individual's sex
17	assigned at birth.
19	"Transgender individual" means an individual whose gender identity is different from the sex
20	assigned to that individual at birth.
21	\tilde{B} . A health carrier offering a health benefit plan providing individual or group health insurance
22	coverage shall:
23	1. Provide coverage under the health benefit plan without discrimination on the basis of gender
24 25	<i>identity or status as a transgender individual; and</i> 2. Treat covered individuals consistent with their gender identity.
23 26	C. A health carrier offering a health benefit plan providing individual or group health insurance
27	coverage shall not deny or limit coverage or impose additional cost sharing or other limitations or
28	restrictions on coverage, under a health benefit plan for health care services that are ordinarily or
29	exclusively available to covered individuals of one sex, to a transgender individual on the basis of the
30	fact that the individual's sex assigned at birth, gender identity, or gender otherwise recorded is different
31	from the one to which such health services are ordinarily or exclusively available.
32 33	D. An individual shall not be subjected to discrimination under a health benefit plan on the basis of gender identity or being a transgender individual, including by being denied coverage of medically
33 34	necessary transition-related care.
35	<i>E.</i> Nothing in this section is intended to determine, or restrict a health carrier from determining,
36	whether a particular health care service is medically necessary or otherwise meets applicable coverage
37	requirements in any individual case.
38	F. A health carrier shall not require any individual, as a condition of enrollment or continued
39	enrollment under a health benefit plan, to pay a premium or contribution that is greater than such
40 41	premium or contribution for a similarly situated covered person enrolled in the plan on the basis of the covered person's gender identity or being a transgender individual
41 42	covered person's gender identity or being a transgender individual. G. Health carriers shall assess medical necessity according to nondiscriminatory criteria that are
43	consistent with current medical standards.
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
