10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 54.1-701 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 54.1-701. Exemptions.
13	The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to:
14	1. Persons authorized by the laws of the Commonwealth to practice medicine and surgery or
15	osteopathy or chiropractic;
16	2. Registered nurses licensed to practice in the Commonwealth;
17	3. Persons employed in state or local penal or correctional institutions, rehabilitation centers,
18	sanatoria, or institutions for care and treatment of individuals with mental illness or intellectual
19	disability, or for care and treatment of geriatric patients, as barbers, cosmetologists, wax technicians, nail
20	technicians, estheticians, barber instructors, cosmetology instructors, wax technician instructors, nail
21	technician instructors, or esthetics instructors who practice only on inmates of or patients in such
22	sanatoria or institutions;
23 24	4. Persons licensed as funeral directors or embalmers in the Commonwealth;
24 25	5. Gratuitous services as a barber, nail technician, cosmetologist, wax technician, tattooer,
25 26	body-piercer, or esthetician; 6. Students enrolled in an approved school taking a course in barbering, nail care, cosmetology,
20 27	waxing, tattooing, body-piercing, or esthetics;
28	7. Persons working in a cosmetology salon whose duties are expressly confined to the blow drying,
<b>2</b> 9	arranging, dressing, curling, or cleansing of human hair;
30	8. Apprentices serving in a barbershop, nail salon, waxing salon, cosmetology salon, or esthetics spa
31	licensed by the Board in accordance with the Board's regulations;
32	9. Schools of barbering, nail care, waxing, or cosmetology in public schools; and
33	10. Persons whose activities are confined solely to applying make-up, including such activities that
34	are ancillary to applying make-up; and
35	11. Persons whose activities are confined solely to removing unwanted hair by the use of string or
36	thread.
