6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 53.1-40.01 of the Code of Virginia, relating to conditional release of
7	geriatric prisoners; exceptions.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 53.1-40.01 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 53.1-40.01. Conditional release of geriatric prisoners; exceptions.
11	Any person serving a sentence imposed upon a conviction for a felony offense, other than (i) a Class
12	1 felony, (ii) if the offense was committed on or after July 1, 2019, murder in the first degree in
13	violation of § 18.2-32, or (iii) if the offense was committed on or after July 1, 2019, a sexually violent
14	offense as defined in § 37.2-900, (i) (a) who has reached the age of sixty-five 65 or older and who has
15	served at least five years of the sentence imposed or (ii) (b) who has reached the age of sixty 60 or
16	older and who has served at least ten 10 years of the sentence imposed may petition the Parole Board
17	for conditional release. The exclusion set forth in clause (iii) shall not apply to any person who is
18	serving a life sentence for any crime other than homicide who was under the age of 18 at the time of
19	the commission of the offense. The Parole Board shall promulgate regulations to implement the
20	provisions of this section.
21	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or

commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and 22 23 24

\$0 for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
