17	December 8, 2017; or	
18	2. An applicant who has successfully (i) completed the educational requirements as required by the

21	C. The Board shall not require, as a condition of licensure, an applicant for a license to practice	
22	barbering or cosmetology to complete more than 1,200 hours of training in the field for which the
