10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 53.1-40.10 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 53.1-40.10. Exchange of medical and mental health information and records.
13	A. Whenever a person is committed to a state correctional facility, the person in charge of the facility
14	or his designee shall be entitled to obtain medical records concerning such person from a health care
15	provider. In addition, medical and mental health information and records of any person committed to the
16	Department of Corrections may be exchanged among the following:
17	1. Administrative personnel for the facility in which the prisoner is imprisoned when there is
18	reasonable cause to believe that such information is necessary to maintain the security and safety of the
19	facility, its employees, or other prisoners. The information exchanged shall continue to be confidential
20	and disclosure shall be limited to that necessary to ensure the safety and security of the facility.
20 21	2. Members of the Parole Board, as specified in § 53.1-138, in order to conduct the investigation

23 24	3. Probation and parole officers for use in parole and probation planning, release, and supervision.
24 25	4. Officials within the Department for the purpose of formulating recommendations for treatment and

20 27	medical, dental, and mental health care, treatment, and programs. 5. Medical and mental health hospitals and facilities, both public and private, including community

30	care, treatment, and programs. 6. The Department for Aging and Rehabilitative Services, the Department of Social Services, and any

32 33	<i>B.</i> Substance abuse records subject to federal regulations, Confidentiality of Alcohol and Drug Abuse
33 34	Patient Records, 42 C.F.R. § 2.11 et seq., shall not be subject to the provisions of this section. The
34 35	disclosure of results of a test for human immunodeficiency virus shall not be permitted except as
33 36	provided in § 32.1-36.1.
30 37	<i>C.</i> The release of medical and mental health information and records to any other agency or
37 38	individual shall be subject to all regulations promulgated by the Department which govern
30 39	confidentiality of such records. Medical and mental health information concerning a prisoner which has
40	been exchanged pursuant to this section may be used only as provided herein and shall otherwise remain
41	confidential and protected from disclosure.
