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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That §§ 54.1-3454 and 54.1-3456.1 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as
12	follows:
13	§ 54.1-3454. Schedule V.
14 15	The controlled substances listed in this section are included in Schedule V: 1. Any compound, mixture, or preparation containing limited quantities of any of the following
15 16	narcotic drugs, which also contains one or more nonnarcotic active medicinal ingredients in sufficient
17	proportion to confer upon the compound, mixture, or preparation, valuable medicinal qualities other than
18	those possessed by the narcotic drug alone:
19	Not more than 200 milligrams of codeine, or any of its salts, per 100 milliliters or per 100 grams;
20	Not more than 100 milligrams of dihydrocodeine, or any of its salts, per 100 milliliters or per 100
21	grams;
22 23	Not more than 100 milligrams of ethylmorphine, or any of its salts, per 100 milliliters or per 100
23 24	grams; Not more than 2.5 milligrams of diphenoxylate and not less than 25 micrograms of atropine sulfate
25	per dosage unit;
26	Not more than 100 milligrams of opium per 100 milliliters or per 100 grams;
27	Not more than 0.5 milligrams of difenoxin and not less than 25 micrograms of atropine sulfate per
28	dosage unit.
29 30	The Board may except by regulation any compound, mixture, or preparation containing any depressant substance listed in subdivision 1 from the application of all or any part of this chapter and
30 31	such substances so excepted may be dispensed pursuant to § 54.1-3416.
32	2. Unless specifically excepted or listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or
33	preparation that contains any quantity of the following substances having a stimulant effect on the
34	central nervous system, including its salts, isomers, and salts of isomers:
35	Pyrovalerone.
36	3. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture,
37 38	or preparation that contains any quantity of the following substances having a depressant effect on the central nervous system, including its salts:
38 39	Brivaracetam ((2S)-2-[(4R)-2-oxo-4-propylpyrrolidin-1-yl] butanamide) (also referred to as BRV;

45 46	§ 54.1-3456.1. Drugs of concern.
46 47	A. The Board may promulgate regulations designating specific drugs and substances, including any controlled substance or other drug or substance where there has been or there is the actual or relative
48	potential for abuse, as drugs of concern. Drugs or substances designated as drugs of concern shall be
49	reported to the Department of Health Professions and shall be subject to reporting requirements for the
50	Prescription Monitoring Program established pursuant to Chapter 25.2 (§ 54.1-2519 et seq.).
51	B. Drugs and substances designated as drugs of concern shall include any material, compound,
52	mixture, or preparation that contains any quantity of the substance tramadol or gabapentin, including its
53 54	salts. Drugs and substances designated as drugs of concern shall not include any nonnarcotic drug that may be lawfully sold over the counter or behind the counter without a prescription.
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
