12	The Board shall adopt regulations on the use of seclusion and restraint in public elementary and
13	secondary schools in the Commonwealth that (i) are consistent with its Guidelines for the Development
14	of Policies and Procedures for Managing Student Behavior in Emergency Situations and the Fifteen
15	Principles contained in the U.S. Department of Education's Restraint and Seclusion: Resource Document;
16	(ii) include definitions, criteria for use, restrictions for use, training requirements, notification
	(ii) include definitions, effective loss restrictions for use, training requirements, notification
17	requirements, reporting requirements, and follow-up requirements; and (iii) address distinctions,
