6 WHEREAS, the Young Entrepreneurs Academy, an organization sponsored by the Loudoun County
7 Chamber of Commerce to teach youth to develop business and nonprofit ideas, was launched in the
8 county in 2017 and finished its second successful year in 2018; and

9 WHEREAS, the mission of the Young Entrepreneurs Academy is to teach middle and high school
10 students how to make a job, not just take a job; the parent organization was founded in 2004 at the
11 University of Rochester with support from the Kauffman Foundation; and

WHEREAS, in its first year, the Young Entrepreneurs Academy in Loudoun County enrolled 29
students; this year, it accepted 24 students out of 50 applicants; the students learn how to develop a
business plan, conduct market research, and deliver a pitch to prospective investors; and

WHEREAS, a year-end competition gives Young Entrepreneurs Academy students the opportunity to
pitch their ideas to a panel of local business leaders with the chance to win a share of \$5,000 in investor
funds and a trip to the national Young Entrepreneurs Academy Saunders Scholars Competition; and
