9 10	WHEREAS, trenching and excavation work are hazardous construction operations performed by
11	many Virginians every day; and
12	WHEREAS, construction employers and employees who work in trenching and excavation need
13	continuous access to education and training in identifying hazards associated with these activities; and
14	WHEREAS, trench collapse deaths are easily preventable with proper shielding, shoring, sloping, and
15 16	training; and WHEREAS, despite increased training and hazard identification, recent national statistics show an
17	alarming increase in trench injuries and deaths, and in 2016, the United States Occupational Safety and
18	Health Administration reported that trench injuries and deaths were nearly double the average of the
19	previous five years; and
20	WHEREAS, the National Utility Contractors Association, a Virginia-based National Construction
21	Trade Association affiliate representing underground utility and excavating contractors, has focused on
22 23	education and training through trenching and excavating hazard awareness programs that are approved by OSHA and sponsored by the North American Excavation Shoring Association; and
23 24	WHEREAS, during Trench Safety Stand Down Week and throughout the year, organizations and
25	individuals in Virginia are encouraged to focus on education and training in trenching and excavating
26	hazard awareness in order to improve the health, safety, and welfare of construction workers and all
27	residents of the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it
28	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly designate
29	the third full week of June, in 2019 and in each succeeding year, as Trench Safety Stand Down Week in
30 31	Virginia; and, be it RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit a copy of this resolution
31 32	to the National Utility Contractors Association so that members of the organization may be apprised of
33	the sense of the General Assembly of Virginia in this matter; and, be it
