WHEREAS, Captain Alvin Deon Branch, USN, Ret., a patriotic veteran who was deeply devoted to 6 his country, community, and family, died on September 2, 2018; and 7

8 WHEREAS, Deon Branch learned the value of responsibility at a young age while working at his 9 family business, the Lynn-Dee Motel in Virginia Beach, and graduated from Maury High School in 10 1946; and

WHEREAS, Deon Branch attended Bullis Preparatory Academy, then entered the United States 11 12 Naval Academy and was commissioned as an officer in 1951; he subsequently earned a master's degree 13 from the Naval Postgraduate School; and

- 14 WHEREAS, during his 30-year military career, Deon Branch served in Korea; was stationed aboard the USS Miller, USS Iowa, USS Hazelwood, and USS Newport News; commanded the USS San 15 Joaquin County, USS Sussex, USS Cromwell, USS Barney, and USS Neosho; achieved the rank of 16 commodore; and worked at the Pentagon; and 17
- 18 WHEREAS, Deon Branch earned numerous awards and accolades, including the Navy 19 Commendation Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, European 20 Occupation Service Medal, Korean Service Medal with Two Bronze Stars, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon, Republic of Korea Presidential Unit Citation, and United Nations Service Medal; and 21
- 22 WHEREAS, Deon Branch's expertise in mathematics, particularly his brilliance with algorithms and 23 statistics, served him well in his second career as a stock and commodity broker for E. F. Hutton on the 24
- New York and Miami Stock Exchanges and later as a tutor to his beloved granddaughters; and 25 WHEREAS, an active member of the community with a zest for life, Deon Branch relished 26 opportunities to entertain family and friends at crab-picking parties and other gatherings at his home in 27 Virginia Beach, where he was a longtime member of the Princess Anne Country Club; and
- 28 WHEREAS, at the age of 60, Deon Branch was paralyzed as a result of a spinal cord injury suffered 29 44 years earlier in a hunting accident near Camp Ashby, which housed German prisoners of war, who stabilized his wounds and helped carry him to Norfolk General Hospital on a makeshift stretcher, 30 31 ultimately saving his life; and
- 32 WHEREAS, after the accident, Deon Branch went on to become a celebrated athlete, both recreationally and in service to his country, and, later in life, his positive attitude and unwillingness to 33 34 be defined by his injury were inspirational to friends and family; and
- 35 WHEREAS, predeceased by his wife, Jacqueline, and son, Deon, Jr., Captain Deon Branch will be 36 fondly remembered and greatly missed by his daughter, Dee, and her family, and numerous other family 37 members and friends; now, therefore, be it
- 38 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 39 note with great sadness the loss of Captain Alvin Deon Branch, USN, Ret., a distinguished veteran and 40 a respected member of the Virginia Beach community; and, be it
- RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 41 for presentation to the family of Captain Alvin Deon Branch, USN, Ret., as an expression of the 42
- 43 General Assembly's respect for his memory.
