WHEREAS, Pepper Laughon also supported the community by volunteering his time and leadership 15 with Kiwanis International, BB&T Bank, the Richmond Eye and Ear Hospital, and Rubicon, Inc.; and 16

WHEREAS, a proud alumnus of Randolph-Macon College, Pepper Laughon served on the 17 institution's Board of Trustees, where he was active with the athletics and student affairs committees and 18 19 the Greek alumni advisory board; and

20 WHEREAS, Pepper Laughon will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his loving wife of 56 21 years, Stuart; his daughters, Catherine and Page, and their families; and numerous other family members, 22 friends, and colleagues; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 24 note with great sadness the loss of Franklin E. Laughon, a businessman who strengthened the Richmond 25 community through his generosity and civic leadership; and, be it
