5 6 WHEREAS, the Honorable Robert John Cochran Wrenn, a respected public servant and a dedicated 7 community leader in Greensville County, will retire as clerk of the Greensville Circuit Court on March 8 1, 2019; and

9 WHEREAS, Robert "Bobby" John Cochran Wrenn has ably served the public as clerk of the 10 Greensville Circuit Court for more than 50 years, winning elections for the position seven consecutive times; he offered his wisdom and expertise to the Virginia Court Clerks' Association as a former board 11 12 member and president; and

13 WHEREAS, Bobby Wrenn served the Commonwealth as an appointed member of the Virginia 14 Community College System State Board for 11 years and as a member of a public records advisory 15 committee; and

16 WHEREAS, Bobby Wrenn has strengthened the community as a longtime member and past president of the Meherrin Ruritan Club, which named him Ruritan of the Year in 2004 and named him a Ruritan 17 18 Forever Member in 2005; and

WHEREAS, Bobby Wrenn has served as a board member of the Salvation Army of Emporia, chair 19 20 of the Rise Against Hunger campaign, and chair of the Bloodmobile, donating blood more than 200 21 times; he has also offered his leadership to the Greensville Bicentennial Committee and the Boy Scouts 22 of America: and

23 WHEREAS, an avid cyclist, Bobby Wrenn established the Great Peanut Bicycle Ride, a beloved 24 local tradition that has welcomed as many as 1,625 participants from 26 states and been featured in 25 national media; and

WHEREAS, for more than five decades, Bobby Wrenn and his wife, Ann, have hosted a Fourth of 26 27 July celebration that promotes community spirit and unity between both local residents and visitors from 28 far and wide; now, therefore, be it

29 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 30 commend the Honorable Robert John Cochran Wrenn on the occasion of his retirement as clerk of the 31 Greensville Circuit Court; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 32 33 for presentation to the Honorable Robert John Cochran Wrenn as an expression of the General 34 Assembly's admiration for his legacy of service to the residents of Greensville County.
