5 WHEREAS, Richardson Grinnan, M.D., an esteemed medical doctor and pulmonary specialist in
7 Richmond, died on July 31, 2018; and

8 WHEREAS, Richardson Grinnan was born in Norfolk, attended St. Christopher's School as a
9 boarding student, and earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from the University of Virginia; he
10 graduated from the Medical College of Virginia, where he was inducted into the Sigma Zeta Honorary
11 Society and Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Society, from which he received the William Harrison Higgins
12 Medicine Award; and

WHEREAS, Richardson Grinnan specialized in the study and treatment of pulmonary disease atMcGuire Clinic in Richmond; and

WHEREAS, among his many contributions, Richardson Grinnan served as president of the Virginia
Thoracic Society and president of the American Lung Association in Virginia; he was a fellow in the
American College of Physicians and American College of Chest Physicians, as well as a member of the
Medical Society of Virginia and Richmond Academy of Medicine; and

19 WHEREAS, Richardson Grinnan joined Blue Cross Blue Shield of Virginia, where he served as a 20 change agent for the insurance company as chief medical officer and senior vice president of quality 21 management; among other appointments, he served as vice chairman on the Board of the Virginia 22 Health Council; on the Governor's Commission on Health Care for All Americans; and on the Board of 23 Directors for Virginia Health Information, Virginians Improving Patient Care and Safety, Virginia Health 24 Quality Center, Virginia Department of Health, and the Medical Society of Virginia Foundation; and

WHEREAS, Richardson Grinnan will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his wife, Lelia;
his children, Richardson, Lelia, and Martha, and their families; and numerous other family members and
