WHEREAS, upon moving to Gloucester in 1991, Chuck Thompson became active in his church and 16 the Gloucester community by joining the Knights of Columbus Council 9428, the American Legion Unit 17 75, the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 8252, and the Moose Lodge 886; and 18

WHEREAS, as a volunteer, Chuck Thompson drove the Veterans Affairs van from the Hampton 19 20 Veterans Affairs Medical Center to the Hunter Holmes McGuire Veterans Administration Medical Center 21 in Richmond; and

22 WHEREAS, predeceased by his son, Charles, Jr., Chuck Thompson will be fondly remembered and 23 greatly missed by his wife, Agnes; his granddaughter, Jeannette, and her family; and numerous other 24 family members and friends; now, therefore, be it
