6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 15.2-1408 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**8 **§ 15.2-1408. Restrictions on activities of former officers and employees by certain counties and**
9 **cities.**10 *A. The term "officer or employee," as used in this section, includes members of local governing*
11 *bodies, county or city officers and employees, and individuals who receive monetary compensation for*
12 *service on or employment by agencies, boards, authorities, sanitary districts, commissions, committees,*
13 *and task forces appointed by the local governing body.*14 *B. In the Counties of Bedford, Fauquier, James City, Pittsylvania, and Stafford, and the Cities of*
15 *Charlottesville and Virginia Beach, the governing body, by ordinance, may prohibit former officers and*
16 *employees, for one year after their terms of office have ended or employment ceased, from providing*
17 *personal and substantial assistance for remuneration of any kind to any party, in connection with any*
18 *proceeding, application, case, contract, or other particular matter involving the county or city or an*
19 *agency thereof, if that matter is one in which the former officer or employee participated personally and*
20 *substantially as a county or city officer or employee through decision, approval, or recommendation.*21 ~~The term "officer or employee," as used in this section, includes members of local governing bodies,~~
22 ~~county or city officers and employees, and individuals who receive monetary compensation for service~~
23 ~~on or employment by agencies, boards, authorities, sanitary districts, commissions, committees, and task~~
24 ~~forces appointed by the local governing body.~~25 *C. In the City of Richmond, the governing body, by ordinance, may prohibit former officers and*
26 *employees, for one year after their terms of office have ended or employment has ceased, from*
27 *representing a client or acting in a representative capacity on behalf of any person or group, for*
28 *compensation, on matters related to ordinances, contracts, proceedings, applications, cases, or other*
29 *matters of any nature involving any agency, department, or office of local government in which the*
30 *former officer or employee served or was employed during the one-year period immediately prior to the*
31 *termination of employment or service. This prohibition shall be in addition to any other prohibition that*
32 *may be provided by law.*
