| 8  | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:   |
| 9  | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-280.2:3 as follows:        |
| 10 | § 22.1-280.2:3. School boards; local law-enforcement agencies; memorandums of understanding.         |
| 11 | The school board in each school division in which the local law-enforcement agency employs school    |
| 12 | resource officers, as defined in § 9.1-101, shall enter into a memorandum of understanding with such |
| 13 | local law-enforcement agency that sets forth the powers and duties of such school resource officers. |
| 14 | Each such school board and local law-enforcement agency shall review and amend or affirm such        |

memorandum at least once every five years or at any time upon the request of either party.
