Law governing open-end credit contract or plan by seller or lender. 11 12 An open-end credit plan as defined and described in § §§ 6.2-300, and 6.2-312 between a seller or lender, whether or not the seller or lender has a physical location in the Commonwealth, and an obligor 13 a Virginia resident shall be governed solely by federal law, and by the laws of the Commonwealth, 14 unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing by the parties. 15
