That the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services shall convene a work 11 group to include representatives of [ the Office of the Attorney General, ] community services boards, 12 local and regional jails, and such other stakeholders as it deems necessary to study the issue of and 13 develop a plan for sharing of protected health information of individuals with mental health treatment 14 15 needs who have been confined to a local or regional jail in the Commonwealth and who have previously received mental health treatment from a community services board or behavioral health 16 authority in the Commonwealth. Such plan shall include a mechanism for (i) determining if an 17 individual confined in a local or regional jail has previously received treatment from a community 18 19 services board or behavioral health authority in the Commonwealth and (ii) in cases in which such 20 person has received such treatment, transferring protected health information related to such treatment 21 from the identified community services board to the sheriff or superintendent of the local or regional jail in which the person is confined. The Department shall report by October 1, 2019, to the Governor and 22 23

the General Assembly on (a) development of the plan, (b) the content of the plan, and (c) the stepsnecessary to implement the plan, including any statutory or regulatory changes and any appropriations.
