19106291D **SENATE BILL NO. 1768** 1 2 AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE 3 (Proposed by the Senate Committee for Courts of Justice 4 on January 30, 2019) 5 6 (Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Mason) A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-1078.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to use of handheld 7 personal communications devices; highway work zones; penalty. 8 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 9 1. That § 46.2-1078.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 46.2-1078.1. Use of handheld personal communications devices in certain motor vehicles; 10 11 exceptions; penalty. A. It is unlawful for any person to operate a moving motor vehicle on the highways in the 12 13 Commonwealth while using any handheld personal communications device to: 14 1. Manually enter multiple letters or text in the device as a means of communicating with another 15 person: or 16 2. Read any email or text message transmitted to the device or stored within the device, provided 17 that this prohibition shall not apply to any name or number stored within the device nor to any caller identification information. 18 B. It is unlawful for any person while driving a moving motor vehicle in a highway work zone to 19 20 hold a handheld personal communications device. 21 C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to: 1. The operator of any emergency vehicle while he is engaged in the performance of his official 22 23 duties: 24 2. An operator who is lawfully parked or stopped; 25 3. The use of factory-installed or aftermarket global positioning systems (GPS) or wireless communications devices used to transmit or receive data as part of a digital dispatch system; or 26 27 4. Any person using a handheld personal communications device to report an emergency. 28 C. D. A violation of this section subsection A is a traffic infraction punishable, for a first offense, by 29 a fine of \$125 and, for a second or subsequent offense, by a fine of \$250. If the violation of this section 30 occurs in a highway work zone, it shall be punishable by a mandatory fine of \$250. For the purposes of this section, "highway work zone" means a construction or maintenance area that is located on or beside 31 32 a highway and marked by appropriate warning signs with attached flashing lights or other traffic control 33 devices indicating that work is in progress. A violation of subsection B is punishable as a Class 1 34 misdemeanor. 35 *E*. For the purposes of this section, "emergency: 36 "Emergency vehicle" means: 37 1. Any law-enforcement vehicle operated by or under the direction of a federal, state, or local 38 law-enforcement officer; 39 2. Any regional detention center vehicle operated by or under the direction of a correctional officer 40 responding to an emergency call or operating in an emergency situation; 3. Any vehicle used to fight fire, including publicly owned state forest warden vehicles, when 41 42 traveling in response to a fire alarm or emergency call; 4. Any emergency medical services vehicle designed or used for the principal purpose of emergency 43 44 medical services where human life is endangered; 5. Any Department of Emergency Management vehicle or Office of Emergency Medical Services 45 vehicle, when responding to an emergency call or operating in an emergency situation; 46 47 6. Any Department of Corrections vehicle designated by the Director of the Department of **48** Corrections, when (i) responding to an emergency call at a correctional facility, (ii) participating in a 49 drug-related investigation, (iii) pursuing escapees from a correctional facility, or (iv) responding to a 50 request for assistance from a law-enforcement officer; and 51 7. Any vehicle authorized to be equipped with alternating, blinking, or flashing red or red and white 52 secondary warning lights pursuant to § 46.2-1029.2. 53 "Highway work zone" means a construction or maintenance area that is located on or beside a highway and is marked by appropriate warning signs with attached flashing lights or other traffic 54 control devices indicating that work is in progress. 55 D. F. Distracted driving shall be included as a part of the driver's license knowledge examination. 56
