INTRODUCED Offered February 4, 2019 Commemorating the 60th anniversary of the closing of Prince Edward County Public Schools. Patrons-McClellan, Dance, Deeds, Locke, Lucas, Peake and Ruff; Delegates: Edmunds, Carr, Fariss, WHEREAS, the Davis v. County School Board of Prince Edward County case was one of the five cases represented in the Brown v. Board of Education lawsuit for school desegregation; and WHÊREAS, the first public schools in the Commonwealth of Virginia to be integrated were in WHEREAS, the federal courts ordered Prince Edward County to integrate its public school system in WHEREAS, on September 10, 1959, the Prince Edward County Board of Supervisors voted not to fund the public schools for the 1959-1960 school year; and WHEREAS, the public schools in Prince Edward County would continue to be closed for a five-year period from 1959 to 1964, longer than anywhere in the country; and WHEREAS, more than 3,000 students were displaced during the school closings; and WHEREAS, public funds from the county were used to open a private school for white students to WHEREAS, the African American students had to attend schools in other localities, create makeshift local options, or go without education for any number of years; and

WHEREAS, the 1964 Supreme Court decision in Griffin v. County School Board of Prince Edward 21 22 County prevents other school divisions across the country from closing public schools and diverting 23 funds to all private schools; and

24 WHEREAS, 2019 marks the 60th anniversary of the closing of the Prince Edward County Public 25 Schools, and the Commonwealth honors those students who had their educations severely impacted 26 during the achievement of school integration; now, therefore, be it

27 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the 60th anniversary of the 28 closing of Prince Edward County Public Schools be commemorated in 2019; and, be it

29 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate transmit a copy of this resolution to the Robert Russa Moton Museum requesting that the museum further disseminate copies of this resolution to 30 their respective constituents so that they may be apprised of the sense of the General Assembly of 31 32 Virginia in this matter.
