memory of the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, among her many accomplishments, Susan Schaar helped oversee the more than \$100
 million renovation of the Virginia State Capitol and is currently overseeing construction of the new
 General Assembly Building; and

WHEREAS, Susan Schaar was also the first Virginian to serve as staff chair of the National
 Conference of State Legislatures and the first Virginian to serve as president of the American Society of
 Legislative Clerks and Secretaries; and

WHEREAS, Susan Schaar joins distinguished colleagues in business, education, health and science,
 human relations, media and marketing, nonprofit management, and volunteering as a recipient of the
 prestigious award; and
