WHEREAS, Bert' Aaron also serves as a member of the board of directors of the Virginia Symphony 19 20 and works with local schools to bring in professional musicians to teach and inspire students; now, 21 therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED by the Senate of Virginia, That Bertram Aaron hereby be commended on his selection 23 as the 2018 Citizen of the Year by the Daily Press; and, be it
