4. Title: Creates an annual mixed beverage performing arts facility license

5. Summary: Creates an annual mixed beverage performing arts facility license, which allows the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption at any multipurpose theater that is located in the historical district of the Town of Bridgewater, and is owned and operated by a governmental entity, and has a total capacity in excess of 100 patrons.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority (“Authority”), the proposed bill would have a minimal fiscal impact.

The current annual fee for an annual mixed beverage license for an entity with more than 100 patrons is \$950. In addition, a mixed beverage licensee is also required to purchase a beer and wine license. The annual fee for a beer and wine license is \$300. As introduced, the proposed bill would likely result in an increase in revenue of \$1,250.
