- **3.** Committee: Education and Health
- **4. Title:** School boards; local law-enforcement agencies, memorandums of understanding.
- **5. Summary:** Requires the school board in each school division in which the local lawenforcement agency employs school resource officers to enter into a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with such local law-enforcement agency that sets forth the powers and duties of the school resource officers. The bill requires each such school board and local lawenforcement agency to review and amend or affirm the memorandum at least once every five years or at any time upon the request of either party.

- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See item 8.
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that this legislation will not have a state fiscal impact. Any impact to localities is indeterminate.
