2. Patron: Gilbert

3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: School boards; local law-enforcement agencies, memorandums of understanding.

5. Summary: Requires the school board in each school division in which the local law-enforcement agency employs school resource officers to enter into a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with such local law-enforcement agency that sets forth the powers and duties of the school resource officers. The bill requires each such school board and local law-enforcement agency to review and amend or affirm the memorandum at least once every five years or at any time upon the request of either party.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this legislation will not have a state fiscal impact. Any impact to localities is indeterminate.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Local school divisions, local law enforcement agencies.

11. Other Comments: SB1563, SB1214, SB1130 and SB1299 also include provisions for MOUs between local law-enforcement agencies and local school division.
