The opportunity for offenders to earn credits by performing community service in lieu of partial payment or payment in full may reduce the amount of revenue available to these funds. However, it is not possible to project how many offenders would choose the community service credit option or to estimate the amount of credits that would be ultimately be earned toward their fines and costs. Therefore, it is not feasible to estimate the reduction in revenue.
