Summary: The substitute bill prohibits anyone regulated under § 54.1-2903, which defines what constitutes as a medical practice, from referencing marijuana in any advertisement, except from including that such person is registered with the Board of Pharmacy to issue written certifications for the use of cannabidiol oil or THC-A oil, as defined in [54.1-3408.3](#).
