**2. Patron:** Orrock

**3. Committee:** Health, Welfare and Institutions

**4. Title:** Funeral services; sale of caskets.

**5. Summary:** Provides that no person other than a licensed funeral establishment or funeral service licensee shall offer for sale or sell a casket unless such offer or sale is made at-need. The bill provides that the requirement that a funeral service licensee accept a casket provided by a third party applies only in cases in which funeral arrangements are made at-need. When funeral arrangements are made preneed, a funeral service licensee is not required to accept caskets provided by third parties.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill, as amended, would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth as it only impacts licensed funeral establishments and funeral service licensees.
