4. Title: Visitors at state correctional facilities; wearing of tampons or menstrual cups.

5. Summary: This bill requires the Department of Corrections to adopt a policy regarding visitors who may be menstruating at the time of their visit to state correctional facilities. The Department is required to make the policy available to the public as soon as practicable and must provide a copy of the policy to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Militia, Police and Public Safety and the Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services by November 1, 2019.
