4. Title: Posting human trafficking hotline information

5. Summary: The proposed bill requires the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority (“Authority”) to post notice of the existence of a human trafficking hotline in government stores, with the exception of government stores established on a distiller’s licensed premises. The bill also requires human trafficking hotline notices to be posted in Virginia Employment Commission employment offices. The purpose is to alert possible witnesses or victims of human trafficking to the availability of a means to report crimes and gain assistance..
