**4. Title:** Public elementary and secondary school students; protective orders; notification.

**5. Summary:** Requires any school principal who receives notice that any circuit court, general district court, juvenile and domestic relations district court, or magistrate has issued a protective order for the protection of any child who is enrolled at a public elementary or secondary school where the principal is employed, to notify the relevant school personnel that such protective order has been issued. The bill requires the Board of Education to establish guidelines and develop model policies to aid local school boards in implementation of the provisions in this act.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that the Board of Education and Department of Education can absorb any costs resulting for the provisions of this bill. Any cost to local school divisions is indeterminate at this time.
