3. Committee: Passed both houses

4. Title: Virginia Community College System; certain registered apprenticeships; uniform instruction.

5. Summary: Requires the Virginia Community College System, in consultation with the Department of Labor and Industry, to develop and deliver uniform, related instruction for registered apprenticeships in high-demand programs, as determined by the Virginia Board of Workforce Development and the Virginia Employment Commission, and for which coursework is not otherwise available. The bill requires such instruction to be available statewide and to be delivered in a face-to-face, online, or blended format.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: HB 1700, the Governor's introduced budget for the biennium included \$130,000 and one position in the second year in support of this legislation. The General Assembly budget retains the introduced funding.
