3. Committee: Appropriations

4. Title: Public institutions of higher education; veterans; withdrawal; tuition refund.

5. Summary: Requires each public institution of higher education to provide a refund of the tuition and mandatory fees paid by any veteran student for any course from which he is forced to withdraw, for the first time, due to a service-connected medical condition during a semester, as certified in writing to the institution by a physician licensed to practice medicine who treated the veteran student for such medical condition.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: Institutions of higher education will lose tuition revenue collected from these students, however it is not possible to estimate how many students will be entitled to a refund per this legislation in any given year.
